Eligibility: The contest is open to all La Salle students in the following categories, Group A (Junior) and Group B (Senior).
Junior: Current La Salle students studying in F.1 to F.5
Senior: Current La Salle students studying in F.6 to F.7 and those who take the HKCEE in 2001 or after

Subject: 1. Sports Craze in La Salle

- 3. My interpretation of La Salle Spirit
- 4. Ways to enhance the relationship between the old boys and current student body
- 5. What I like the most in La Salle

Word limit: Not less than 400 for Group A and not less than 800 for Group B

- Submission: All entries must be sent to <u>lscpb.oba.writing@gmail.com</u>. Participants should include their name, class (for current students only), year taking HKCEE (for old boys only) and contact information in the email. However, in the essay itself, there should not be any information about the author so as to allow anonymous judging.
- Judging: All submissions will be reviewed for pre-selection. 10 finalists will be chosen from each category. The finalists' entries will be reviewed by 4 groups of judges. Group 1 judges consist of representatives of the school management and teachers. Group 2 judges consist of representatives of the various old boys association and chapters. Group 3 judges consist of representatives of the sponsors (old boys). Group 4 judges are the current and former students of La Salle. The final score for each entry will be the weighted average of the scores from the 4 groups of judges: 30% for groups 1 3 and 10% for group 4.
